Mayfield Grain Company, Inc., founded in 1986, began serving the agriculture community at its North 9th street location with 750,000 bushels of grain storage.

Four years later, we acquired a second facility on Allen Street, which increased our grain handling capacity. In 2001 we began new construction at the southside with additional grain storage and new dump pits, and have continued to grow with 5 more expansions since.

In 2004, Mayfield Grain merged business with Sunwray Fertilizer on Highway 94 West. Now Sunwray Fertilizer is known as Mayfield Grain 94. With this acquisition we gained even more grain storage.

In the winter of 2013 we moved into our new office on the southside. We have put in a new set of 80 ft scales and a new grain probe. In January of 2014 we demolished the old office, the last of the original buildings from Howe-Hilliard. With the office out of the way, we began the dirtwork for 3 more 330,000 bushel bins. Along with this new addition, we added another dump pit, resized our 2 existing dump pits to double the unloading speed to cut down on truck lines at harvest. In 2016 We added another 1.4 million bushels of storage by adding 4 more 330,000 bushel tanks and a 60,000 bushel hopper. The photo above is the facility at our current capacity.
